



FY2019 HfHGBR income limits are based on the Median Family Income (MFI) calculations issued by HUD each fiscal year. Iberville Parish is the only one in the HfHGBR coverage area with a different MFI and therefore different Income Limits. Each year upon the release of the new MFI numbers, HfHGBR will recalculate its income limits by finding 27% and 60% of the MFI for a family of four to get the minimum and maximum incomes. Those numbers will then be adjusted for family size based in accordance with the method HUD uses and describes in its Fiscal Year Income Limits Briefing Material.
